The Warrick County Commissioners met in regular session with Sarah Seaton, President; Stacey Franz, Vice President; and Terry Phillippe, Member.

Attorney Cliff Whitehead and Administrator Debbie Bennett-Stearsman were in attendance.

Auditor Michael Dietsch and Recording Secretary Kristine Georges attended and recorded the minutes.

President Sarah Seaton called the meeting to order at 4:00 PM.

PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE

AREA PLAN COMMISSION
REQUEST FOR EXTENSION OF SURETY
BELLEVUE SECTION 2: CD REAL ESTATE DEVELOPMENT

Area Plan Director Molly Barnhill presented a Request for the Extension of Surety. It is Bellevue Section 2 by CD Real Estate Development Inc., Donnie Denton, Member. The County is holding two letters of credit for street construction at \$5,000.00 and \$3,999.00 for sidewalk construction. They are requesting a one-year extension at the same dollar amount and have had a letter of credit for six years. The letter of credit expires August 12, 2025. County Engineer Bobby Howard said that the amounts were sufficient. Commissioner Terry Phillippe made a motion to approve. Commissioner Stacey Franz seconded the motion. The motion carried 3-0.

REQUEST FOR RELEASE OF SURETY
PEACHWOOD PUD REPLAT OF LOT 5

Next was a Request for the Release of Surety for Peachwood PUD, Replat of Lot 5, Nine Ten Five Properties LLC, by Chad Lampert, Member. The County is holding \$22,264.00 in escrow guaranteeing the construction of Peachwood Court, a private road. They have had three years. The surety expires August 4, 2025. Mr. Howard said that construction was complete and recommended release. Commissioner Terry Phillippe made a motion to approve the release. Commissioner Stacey Franz seconded the motion. The motion carried 3-0.

REQUEST TO REZONE
PC-R-25-06
ORDINANCE 2025-09

Ms. Barnhill presented a Request to Rezone, PC-R-25-06. Petitioner and owner is S & B Development Group LLC, by Chris Brown, Member. It's to rezone approximately 15.762 acres located on the north side of Pollack Avenue approximately 0 feet west of the intersection of Pollack Avenue and Morningside Drive from A, Agricultural to R-1, One-Family Dwelling. Ohio Township 32-6-9. Complete legal is on file. It was advertised in The Standard on May 29, 2025. The Area Plan Commission gave a favorable recommendation for PC-R-25-06 at the meeting held on June 9, 2025.

Scott Buedel was present. He said the property is surrounded by R-zoned properties and would be a good fit for the area. They have taken care of the road accesses and hope to have approval. There was one person present that had a question on whether there would be access to Basin Drive. Mr. Buedel said that it would. There were no remonstrators.

Commissioner Terry Phillippe made the motion to approve the rezoning, Ordinance 2025-09. Commissioner Stacey Franz seconded the motion. The motion carried 3-0.

STREET CONSTRUCTION PLANS
PP-25-06: WILLOW LANDING

Last were Street Construction Plans for PP-25-06, Willow Landing. The petitioner and owner is S & B Development Group LLC, by Chris Brown, Member. It's approximately 15.762 acres located on the north side of Pollack Avenue approximately zero feet west of the intersection of Pollack Avenue and Morningside Drive. Ohio Township 32-6-9. Complete legal is on file. It was advertised in The Standard on July 3, 2025. Ms. Barnhill said they would be coming before the APC at their meeting tonight to discuss the layout of the plat. Glen Meritt was present to discuss the project. He said their only connection was at Basin Street where the twenty-nine lots will be. Mr. Howard said the plans met the Subdivision Control Ordinance and he recommended approval. Commissioner Terry Phillippe made the motion to approve. Commissioner Stacey Franz seconded the motion. The motion carried 3-0.

SIDEWALK ACKNOWLEDGEMENT/REQUEST TO RELEASE SURETY
BERKSHIRE PHASE 5

Next was a Sidewalk Acknowledgement and Request to Release surety for Berkshire Phase 5. This includes Brompton/Abbe Wood Drive at 1,538 lineal feet and Camden Drive at 1,566 lineal feet for Maken LLC, by Danny Ubelhor, President. The County is holding \$1,434.50 in escrow guaranteeing sidewalk construction. They have had

the letter of credit for 5 years. It expires August 12, 2025. The County Engineer was good with the acknowledgement and requests. Commissioner Stacey Franz made the motion to approve. Commissioner Terry Phillippe seconded the motion. The motion carried 3-0.

ITEMS FOR DISCUSSION

PROJECT PARTNERSHIP UPDATE - JAIL

Mr. Bill Nix was present and had handouts for the Commissioners. They have had no recordable incidents. He went over what is currently being worked on and what was complete. They are on track to finish next year. He also presented some paperwork for the Commissioners to sign today. It was an application for the water meter from Chandler. Counsel will review the paperwork.

Byron Sanders with Project Partnership also spoke to the financial part of the project. He went over the supplemental account and only 24% has been spent. In the contingency accounts, they have not used anything. Any money not used will go back to the County.

ADA COMPLIANCE OFFICER

Commissioner Phillippe asked that this be put on the agenda. There was discussion on appointing Building Inspector Jeff Daily. Ms. Bennett-Stearsman said that Mr. Daily felt he was the person that should do it. The history of the position was discussed. Mr. Howard reviewed how the position worked and that a new transition plan is supposed to be developed and updated regularly. Whoever is in the position would need to get them up to date and use a consultant such as Hafer to get it done. He does have a hard copy from the last plan that was done in 2018. Mr. Howard also went over why the HR was a part of this. Commissioner Phillippe felt it was a dual role. There was more discussion. There is a meeting with Hafer and Clark Dietz on getting quotes on what will be needed to be done. Mr. Howard said that someone in the Commissioner's Office really does need to be apart of it. Ms. Bennett-Stearsman is good with taking care of some of the administrative duties. Attorney Whitehead said that they did have to have one person appointed, and they need to be able to field complaints. It was understood that Mr. Daily will be appointed but Ms. Bennett-Stearsman will be helping him in some of the areas. Commissioner Stacey Franz made a motion to appoint Jeff Daily. Commissioner Terry Phillippe seconded the motion. The motion carried 3-0.

INITIATION OF CUM DRAIN FUND INCREASE

DENNIS WILZBACHER

Surveyor Dennis Wilzbacher was present to discuss the need to fund the care of the drainage in Warrick County. He is here to request the initiation of the increase of the Cum Drain Fund. It has never been raised and at one point they heard it was lowered. If raised, it would create an additional \$200,000.00 needed to fund projects and get them to a point in the next six years and then maintenance with different programs. The County is a lot lower than many of the counties in the State. Annually, it currently generates \$200,000.00 which only leaves \$56,000.00 to take care of any drainage after overhead. He went over what the additional funding would cover. They discussed current costs and miles of ditch in the county. He has big concerns about areas going under water if drainage is not properly taken care of. They also discussed recent flooding issues and costs of the flooding much of it because of drainage.

Warrick County resident and farmer, Phil Springston, also spoke. The legal drains, three on his property, haven't been cleaned by the County since 1980. The current tax rate was discussed and what they would like it to raise to right now. This is less that what it can be raised to. The Farm Bureau is also in support of this. There was a brief discussion on what this would look like as far as taxes on a \$100,000.00 assessment. It would be pennies on the dollar.

Commissioner Phillippe asked what his vision was for this. Mr. Wilzbacher would like see how they do with the plan and then see the cost go down. It's going to be baby steps.

Attorney Whitehead said it would be up to the Council to make the raise, but that the Commissioners can certainly support the effort. It was Mr. Wilzbacher's understanding that the Commissioners had to initiate as Cum Drain was under their purview. He also wants to make sure to make any deadlines. If for some reason, the Commissioners do need to take that kind of step, they can address it at that time. Commissioner Terry Phillippe made a motion to support Mr. Wilzbacher in his efforts. Commissioner Stacey Franz seconded the motion. The motion carried 3-0.

HEALTH DEPARTMENT

APPOINTMENTS

Dr. Paul Perry has resigned from the Health Board and they now need to fill this. Ms. Kathy Clodfelter's term has also expired. Both need to be addressed. There was a recommendation of Dr. David Whitney in order to keep a licensed doctor on the board. Ms. Clodfelter's appointment just needs to be renewed. Commissioner Stacey Franz made a motion to reappoint Kathy Clodfelter. Commissioner Terry Phillippe seconded the motion. The motion carried 3-0.

Commissioner Franz would like time to look for a possible general practitioner to take Dr. Perry's place. She would also like to collaborate with the City of Boonville. She also went over some other things she would like to see with the chosen appointment. Commissioner Phillippe wanted to make sure that Ohio Township, which makes up the majority of the County in population, is represented on the Health Board, not just Boonville. Commissioner Seaton wants to see the right person that maybe works with more of the at-risk population and not necessarily a specialist. Dr. Kahre said she would be happy to reach out to the mayor and others. They also welcomed Ms. April Hicks as the new Health Administrator.

**RATIFICATION OF DAYVILLE MAINTENANCE
SERVICE AGREEMENT – EMA**

Ms. Bennett-Stearsman presented a service agreement to be approved for the work of Dayville for the EMA. Matt Goebel spoke briefly. This is for service work on the light plants that they use for emergencies such as the recent building collapse. Commissioner Terry Phillippe made the motion to ratify. Commissioner Stacey Franz seconded the motion. The motion carried 3-0.

Mr. Goebel also wanted to thank the Highway Department for their work after the fire loss of the Education Center in Newburgh.

OHIO FIRE DEPARTMENT REQUEST

The Ohio Township Fire Department is requesting funding for a Lucas Device which provides chest compressions. The cost of the equipment is \$27,380.18. Ms. Bennett-Stearsman said it can come from opioid restricted or unrestricted. The only concern was if they do for one fire department, they may have to do it for all. That would cost \$246,412.00. Commissioner Seaton was familiar with the equipment and gave info on how it works. She would like to see it benefit the paid fire departments, but would like to see numbers run for the volunteer stations. Steven Byers, Boonville Fire Chief, was questioned about it. He said there is a higher survivability if one is used. Boonville has looked at getting one, but hasn't been able to. Commissioner Terry Phillippe made the motion to get one for Boonville and one for Ohio Township out of Opioid restricted and to look at other departments. Commissioner Stacey Franz seconded the motion. The motion carried 3-0.

**ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT
EDC APPOINTMENTS**

Economic Development Director came before the Commissioner to discuss the current Economic Development Commission appointments. He went over what this board does and that it is rarely used. There are however some upcoming things that they would need the use of the commission. Mr. Roelle is trying to get everything in order and approved so the individuals can be given an oath which has been scheduled. He went over the recommendations and said they must be officially Commissioner approved.

OPEN BIDS, TRAFFIC SIGNAL CONTRACT**

Acquisitions Administrator Sherrie Sievers presented bids for the County's Traffic Signal Service Contract. Invitations to bid were sent to Mounts Electric, Hummel Electric, and Ragle. All IC codes were followed. Only one bid was received by Ragle. She presented all quoted areas and the cost. Ms. Sievers also went over hourly rates. She deferred to Mr. Howard on his recommendation. He asked the Commissioners to take it under advisement for them to review. Commissioner Terry Phillippe made the motion to take under advisement. Commissioner Stacey Franz seconded. The motion carried 3-0.

Ms. Sievers brought an issue before the Commissioners. Southern Indiana Wild Game Management has done work for the County several times. They don't do the umbrella for insurance and cannot afford the charges involved with doing so being a small operation. No one else provides this service. She did reach out to Brian Hancock with the County Insurance. He noted that it would be a business decision for the Commissioners and that all the suggestions they make are what are recommended.

Steven Byers and Charlie Clutter with Southern Indiana Wild Game Management were present to answer any questions. Ms. Sievers suggested waving the umbrella policy for them in this instance. There is currently work on the books that needs to be taken care of. Commissioner Stacey Franz made the motion to wave the umbrella policy. Commissioner Terry Phillippe seconded the motion. The motion carried 3-0.

ROGER AND MARY WINSTEAD**



AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE WARRICK COUNTY, INDIANA
COMPREHENSIVE ZONING ORDINANCE BY REZONING CERTAIN
REAL ESTATE IN WARRICK COUNTY, INDIANA

**BE IT ORDAINED BY COMMISSIONERS OF WARRICK
COUNTY, INDIANA:**

Section 1. That the Warrick County, Indiana Comprehensive Zoning Ordinance and the Warrick County Zoning District Maps dated February 1, 2005 and made a part of said Ordinance, be and the same are hereby amended as follows:

That the boundaries of the "AG" District as shown on said Warrick County Zoning District Maps, be amended as to the described real estate:

Part of the Southwest Quarter of the Southeast Quarter of Section 32, Township 6 South, Range 9 West in Ohio Township, Warrick County, Indiana and being more particularly described as follows:

Commencing at the Southeast Corner of said Quarter Quarter Section; thence along the south line of said Quarter Quarter Section, North 88 Degrees 49 Minutes 02 Seconds West 264.00 feet to the point of beginning; thence continue along the south line of said Quarter Quarter Section, North 88 Degrees 49 Minutes 02 Seconds West 294.48 feet to a point on the north boundary of Huntington Creek, Section A, as per plat thereof, recorded in Document Number 2004R-010974 in the Office of the Recorder of Warrick County, Indiana; thence along the north line of said Huntington Creek, North 88 Degrees 03 Minutes 59 Seconds West 121.84 feet; thence continue along the north line of said Huntington Creek, North 86 Degrees 37 Minutes 51 Seconds West 199.58 feet; thence continue along the north line of said Huntington Creek, North 78 Degrees 32 Minutes 59 Seconds West 23.45 feet to the southeast corner of a tract of land conveyed to Baker Investments, LLC in Document 2013R-002977 in the Office of said Recorder; thence along the east boundary of said Baker Investments tract, North 00 Degrees 58 Minutes 07 Seconds East 676.27 feet to a point on the south line of Epworth Village No. 2, as per plat thereof, recorded in Plat Book 4, pages 195-196 in the Office of said Recorder; thence along the south line of said Epworth Village, South 89 Degrees 26 Minutes 52 Seconds East 237.80 feet to the southeast corner thereof; thence along the east line of said Epworth Village, North 01 Degree 50 Minutes 54 Seconds East 627.02 feet; thence South 89 Degrees 18 Minutes 06 Seconds East 350.32 feet to center of Morningside Drive as described in Document 1973R-023556 in the Office of said Recorder and being the beginning of a curve to the right having a central angle of 34 Degrees 39 Minutes 36 Seconds, a radius of 220.00 feet and a chord dimension of South 16 Degrees 26 Minutes 50 Seconds East 131.07 feet; thence along the center of Morningside Drive and along the arc of said curve 133.09 feet; thence along the center of Morningside Drive and the extended center of Morningside Drive, South 00 Degrees 52 Minutes 58 Seconds West 1197.32 feet to the point of beginning and containing a gross area of 15.762 Acres, more or less.
