**AREA PLAN COMMISSION
STREET PLANS
PP-25-14 CASTLE RIDGE**

Area Plan Director Molly Barnhill presented street plans for PP-25-14, Castle Ridge, a replat of Lot 7. Petitioner and owner is Jeffrey L. and Cai Yuan Stern, Trustees of the Jeffrey Stern and Cai Yuan Living Trust/Gregory S. and Mary M. Huffman. It's approximately 1.510 acres located on the south side of Windsor Court approximately 650 feet east of the intersection of Windsor Court and south Coal Mine Road. Being Lot 7 in Castle Ridge, recorded in Document 2021R-009003, Ohio Township. It was advertised in The Standard November 27, 2025. They are requesting no improvements to Windsor Court. Glen Meritt with Cash Waggnar was present. He said it's an additional lot on the back of Lot 7. County Engineer Bobby Howard said that he recommended approval. Commissioner Terry Phillippe made a motion to approve. Commissioner Stacey Franz seconded the motion. The motion carried 3-0.

**ITEMS FOR DISCUSSION
DISCUSSION REGARDING SOFTWARE
JEFF DAILY AND APRIL HICKS**

Building Commissioner Jeff Daily and Health Administrator April Hicks were present to discuss new software. He said originally, when he was Inspector, the nuisance ordinance stuff was difficult to take care of and keep it documented so they have looked at some software. They got three bids for the process. He then got in touch with Health Department and they would be able to use this as well. This would be more cost efficient for both departments. He said that this is just a discussion right now. They also touched on the fees and what all would be stored on the program as well as possible collaboration with other departments. They would really like to get it signed by the end of the year. The Commissioners asked questions about putting a demonstration together and getting it scheduled for other departments to get information. Commissioners would also like a comparison and contrast on the different programs to help see the differences. Commissioner Phillippe asked about the terms of agreements and costs. There was a brief discussion. Mr. Daily again said this was all just information at this time and he can see about scheduling demos. No other action was taken.

DISTRIBUTION OF CVET AND FIT

Administrator Debbie Bennett-Stearnsman reviewed. They need to distribute from CVET at \$28,786.00 and FIT at \$19,093.00. This was something that was distributed by settlement. Now, it comes by checks and is decided by the Commissioners what funds to put them into. The Commissioners discussed the allocation and about putting the lump sum into Cum Cap. Mr. Howard would normally get a small portion of those funds and said that he would be able to use out of Cum Cap as approved by the Board. Commissioner Terry Phillippe made a motion to approve the allocation to Cum Cap, Fund 1138. Commissioner Stacey Franz seconded the motion. The motion carried 3-0.

disasters. It's been in place for some time and is paid out of Commissioner's budget. The contract total is \$2,275.00. It is a year contract. Commissioner Stacey Franz made a motion to approve. Commissioner Terry Phillippe seconded the motion. The motion carried 3-0.

MILEAGE**

Next, was the Non-Certified Voucher in the amount of \$1,150.00. There were mileage discrepancies. They don't have the same starting point and there was a large difference between the three amounts. There was discussion on what is considered the starting point and what is used for mileage. Odometer readings were what were turned in. There was continued discussion. Commissioner Seaton recommended approving since there is no policy on a starting point, but requesting going forward that a MapQuest of the mileage be provided either from the Courthouse or their home, whatever is closer. The other Commissioners were in agreement. Commissioner Phillippe asked if the Ordinance needed to be changed with doing that. Attorney Whitehead said that it's not specific in the ordinance so it's not modifying anything in the ordinance. Commissioner Terry Phillippe made a motion to approve the mileage reimbursement. Commissioner Stacey Franz seconded the motion. The motion carried 3-0.

SLURRY PIT UPDATE**

Attorney Cliff Whitehead gave an update on the Ayrshire Dam. The owner is moving forward with requirements necessary with DNR and a firm to investigate. Attorney Whitehead reviewed that process. The County continues to receive updates, and it is under active review.

COMMENTS FROM THE PUBLIC

Mr. Jim Shields, 8355 Chestnut Drive. He had a list to ask, but the Attorney's statement answered many. He thanked them for the follow up. He will continue to come to keep up to date.

Commissioner Phillippe said that he wanted to note specifically that the Drainage Board requested, through the prior Surveyor, that the land owner provide the County with their scope of work. That doesn't mean he'll give it to us, but it has been requested.

Danielle Hudson, 6033 Gardener Road, Chandler. She can't make the Drainage Board meeting, but she was also there to speak on the slurry pit. She said it became a public issue when it involved public safety. She also said there were super funds available to use for it.

Mr. Jim Shields spoke again. He spoke about the Extension Contract. He also spoke about the data center that has been spoken about and they would need to build a massive power plant. Commissioner Phillippe said that they have not been approached and it is a consultant that is looking into the area. He thinks that this is no more than exploratory at this time and a 'what it might look like' if it happened. Mr. Shields talked about running a tax-free county with the new companies coming in.

Ms. Bennett-Stearnsman wanted to state that a super fund is for brownfields. This is not a brownfield. Brownfields are commercial sites and chemicals have been used and gone into the ground. It has to have a commercial or industrial structure. Ms. Hudson thanked her for the clarification.
