An eligible entity may apply to the adopting body for a distribution of public safety LIT revenue if it: (1) provides fire protection or emergency medical services within a county; and (2) is operated by or serves a political subdivision. The application must occur before July 1 and any distribution would be made in the following calendar year. The adopting body must review an application for a distribution to a township at a public hearing. The adopting body must give notice of the public hearing under Ind. Code § 5-3-1, and the township must present and explain its application at the public hearing. The adopting body may review multiple applications at one (1) public hearing. The resolution that the adopting body may adopt for a distribution to a township cannot be adopted later than ten (10) days after the public hearing. The deadline to adopt a resolution remains August 31 of the year before the year the distribution is made. Clarification of Maximum Amount of Distribution to Eligible Entities Second, the maximum amount that may be distributed to an eligible entity has been clarified to be one hundred percent (100%) of the revenue collected from that portion of the tax rate imposed for the public safety allocation that does not exceed a rate of five one-hundredths of one percent (0.05%). The distribution to each entity must be based on the assessed value of real property, not including land, that is served by each applicable entity. Any amount of LIT revenue distributed under Ind. Code § 6-3.6-6-8(d) shall be distributed before the remainder of tax revenue is allocated under Ind. Code § 6-3.6-6-8(b). In other words, the distribution of public safety LIT revenue to the above entities is made after the PSAP allocation and before the allocation to the county and municipality to other public safety purposes.
